> A DYNAMIC ECONOMY

- Nominal GDP (current euro): €6.63 billion
- **GDP** growth: +7.5%
- GDP per capita: €75 942
- GDP per employed person: €114 600
- More than 5 600 companies and 58 000 employees on 2km2
- A large skilled labour force coming mainly from France and Italy
- High added value, non-polluting companies

> A BALANCED AND DIVERSIFIED HUB (GDP per sector)

- Scientific and technical activities administrative and support services: 17.8%;
- Financial and insurance activities: 16.7%;
- Construction: 9.9%;
- Real estate activities: 9.2%;
- Accommodation and food service activities: 9.1%;
- Public administration, education, health and social work: 7%;
- Wholesale trade: 8.3%;
- Retail trade: 5.4%;
- Information and communication: 5.1%;
- Transportation and storage: 3.4%;
- Manufacturing, mining and guarrying ant other industries: 3.1%
- Other service activities: 3%.

> A SUSTAINABLE MODEL

- **Unrivalled political stability** the Grimaldi Dynasty has governed Monaco for over 700 years
- An unparalleled balance between a free-market economy and the social welfare of its people
- A debt-free economy, with reserve funds equal to 4 years of state expenditure (2 in liquid assets) A balanced budget (€1.5 billion) of which 30% on average have been invested in infrastructure and amenities over the last 50 years
- **Major projects**: six-hectare land extension project for 2025 in compliance with environmental restrictions, to meet the growing needs of residents and investors A fiscal regime relying on
- indirect rather than direct taxation (VAT at 20% represents 50% of state revenue)
- A structure to combat money-laundering and terrorism financing, embracing fiscal transparency and cooperation, unanimously recognised by international organisations like GAFI and the OECD
- A policy that promotes renewable energy and sustainable mobility
- Objectives to cut emissions by 50% by 2030 and be carbon neutral by 2050.
